- 1 Are you eager to get out of the city and go into the woods? The opening of the Lebanon Mountain Trail (LMT), a 440-kilometer-hiking trail that goes across Lebanon from Qubaiyat in the north to Marjayoun in the south, has made this thrilling experience within easy reach of both local and foreign nature lovers.
- 2 The LMT runs through more than 75 towns and villages, and it is divided into 26 sections, each between 10 and 20 km long. Hikers can choose the section they wish to walk, and they can rent a room to spend a night in family guesthouses, *ecolodges*, camps or small hotels with full facilities to cater for the hiker's needs whether alone or in groups. Hikers will enjoy the beautiful scenery, participate in a variety of activities, and experience the Lebanese *hospitality* and cuisine.
- 3 Hikers on the LMT will have the chance to discover different parts of the two dramatic mountain ranges in the country, the vast fertile Beqaa valley between them, many rivers and springs, and, of course, the famous ancient cedar forests. They will get to know Lebanon's rich heritage, support villagers by buying their local produce and handicrafts, or even help farmers harvest their seasonal crops: cherries, peaches, grapes, apples, or olives.
- 4 A number of hospitality establishments have been recently founded to take advantage of the interesting outdoor recreational activities along the trail. Not only do they organize a one-day hike along the trail, but they also offer hikers a variety of winter and summer activities during their trip, such as mountain biking, snowshoeing, *back-country* skiing, swimming, river rafting, herb picking, and donkey riding in remote villages. In some ecolodges, hikers can even practice yoga and meditation at an additional cost.
- 5 In addition to helping people enjoy varied recreational activities, these hospitality establishments have other goals. **One** is to train hikers, especially kids, on how to preserve the environment from threats and become more environmentally friendly. Hikers become familiar with various wild plants, birds and insects. Another goal is to support villagers with the money the hikers bring to rural areas. **This** helps villagers become more rooted in their land and take good care of **it**.
