III- <u>Text</u>

« Alienation consists firstly of work which is external to the laborer, this is to say it does not relate to his essence. Here, he does not assert but denies himself, neither does he feel at ease, but unhappy, nor does he deploy a physical or an intellectual liberal activity, where his body is mortified and his spirit is ruined. Consequently, when he works, he is not himself. Therefore his work is not voluntary but constrained, it is a forced work. Work is not the satisfaction of a need, but only a means to satisfy needs outside work. The alienating character of work appears clearly when physical or other constraints no longer exist, the worker escapes from work, like he is escaping from plague. Work where man is alienated, is a work of self sacrifice, of mortification.

...Finally, the external character of work, appears in fact to the laborer, that it does not belong to him but to someone else, so is the laborer in his work he does not belong to himself but to someone else. In this way the activity of the laborer does not belong to the worker himself but this activity belongs to someone else and this is the loss of his self.»
