Deforestation

- 1 Deforestation is the removal of trees in order to use land and wood for residential, commercial, or industrial purposes. Nowadays, deforestation has become a threatening environmental problem because of its immediate and long-term effects. Although trees are absolutely vital for life on Earth, forests have been destroyed around the globe at an alarming rate. Deforestation is caused by a combination of human and nature factors that have a dramatic impact on Earth.
- 2 Deforestation has many causes, one of which is logging operations related to business and to people's need to support their families. The action of loggers who provide the world's wood and paper products leads to the loss of a countless number of trees every year. Also, in many countries, some loggers often act illegally to make more money by exploiting forests for their own interests, so further deforestation takes place.
- 3 Another cause of deforestation is forest fires that destroy hundreds of trees in many places around the world. Some forests are replaced by exotic² plants which are not suitable for the environment because **they** shed a lot of dry leaves that act as firelighters. This makes the place a huge fire hazard that might cause great damage to the close forests.
- 4 The problem of deforestation contributes³ to the greenhouse effect that increases the speed and severity of global warming. Trees are large stores of carbon dioxide, and when they are burnt, **they** release this gas. Consequently, there will be an increase in the carbon dioxide level in the air which, in turn, is a major contributor to the greenhouse effect.
- 5 Trees are essential for land stability. If there are no trees, the possibility of soil erosion and mudslides increases. The shade of trees helps the soil remain moist. When trees are cut, the soil directly exposed to the sun- becomes dry and causes soil erosion. In addition, when it rains, trees absorb and store large amounts of water; therefore, cutting trees makes water flow haphazardly, causing dangerous mudslides.
- 6 Preventing deforestation is a personal responsibility that people have to take. They should carefully manage the natural resources by eliminating clear-cutting. Besides, they should maintain balance by planting enough new trees to replace the ones cut. Through the involvement in such appropriate environmental activities, the devastated areas might regain their natural attraction and pump again with life.
