First Subject:

Third Subject: Text

What we mean by the unconscious is every process that is currently active within us without being aware of, and without knowing anything about it. So far, we haven't learned anything new, and nothing at all gives us the right to introduce the concept of the unconscious in psychology. However, the Para praxes allow us to make a new experiment. Suppose for example a person commits a slip of the tongue, we are obliged to accept that this error reveals verbal intentionality, and without the risk of being mistaken, we can guess (know) the nature of this intentionality, which could not manifest itself, and which is therefore considered unconscious. If we later reveal this intentionality to the person, he might produce two positions: either he recognizes it; hence we deduce that it was only a temporary unconscious, or else he denies it because it permanently exists in his unconscious. This experiment allows us to consider that the unconscious is all what we have previously qualified as latent (not known).
