Third Subject: Text

...There is in the depths of souls an innate principle of justice and virtue, on which, in spite of our own maxims, we judge our actions and those of others as good or bad, and to this principle I give the name conscience.

Once I pronounce this word, it raises, in one claim, the voices of those who pretend wisdom: childhood errors, prejudices of education! Nothing is in the human mind except what is introduced by experience, and we do not judge anything except through acquired ideas.

Therefore, we should distinguish between our acquired ideas and our natural sentiments; as we feel before we know; and as we do not learn to approach what is good for us and avoid what is bad, because we hold this as a will of nature, the love of the good and the hatred of the evil are natural to us as is the love of ourselves. Thus, the acts of conscience are sentiments not judgments.
