**Choose** <u>one</u> of the following three subjects:

### First Subject:

Social phenomena are natural facts that submit to the laws of positive science.

- 1- Explain this judgment of 'Auguste Comte' and state the (9 points) problematic it raises.
  - Write <u>an introduction revolving</u> around social sciences.
  - Write <u>a suitable problematic</u>. A general problem and a specific problem.
  - Write <u>a suitable preliminary</u> idea:
  - Explain this judgment showing the method that is being followed in the explanatory method.
  - The point of view of Auguste Comte and Durkheim.
- 2- Discuss this judgment in light of the comprehensive method (7 points) in sociology.
  - Write <u>a transitional sentence</u> that links the explanation with the discussion.
  - **Internal criticism**: two ideas.
  - External criticism: explain the importance of the comprehensive method
    - Explain and give examples.
  - Write a <u>synthesis joining</u> both theories.

# **3-** Do you think that sociological studies of unemployment could help in finding solutions for it? Justify your answer.

- **Explain** the question.
- Answer with yes, social studies helps in finding solutions to unemployment (Justification and give two examples).
- If Answer with no, it does not help (Justification and give two examples).

### Second Subject:

Philosophy is an explorative adventure which aims at enlightening science.

- 1- Explain this judgment of 'Russel' and state the problematic it (9 points) raises.
  - Write <u>an introduction</u> about the two types of knowledge (philosophy and science).
  - Write <u>a suitable problematic</u>: A general problem and a specific problem.
  - Write <u>a preliminary idea</u>.
  - **Explain** <u>this judgment</u> state the complementarity between philosophy and science.
  - **Specify** the points of similarity between science and philosophy, they benefit from each other.
  - They are both two ways of human thought (give examples).

# 2- Discuss this judgment showing the difference and the (7 points) contradiction between science and philosophy.

- Write <u>a transitional sentence</u> that links the explanation with the discussion.
- Internal criticism: two ideas.
- External criticism: present the contradictory theory and the differences between science and philosophy in relation to topics, method and results.
- Write a synthesis joining both theories.

- **3-** Do you think that teaching philosophy helps to improve the (4 points) behavior of the learner? Justify your answer.
  - **Explain** the question.
  - Answer with yes, philosophy could have a positive role (Justification and give two examples).
  - If Answer with no, does not play any role (Justification and give two examples).

#### **Third Subject:** Text

For consciousness to be able to **imagine**, it must intrinsically escape from the world. It must be able in itself to a set back position towards the world. In one word, it must be **free**. [...]

**Imagination is not an empirical superadded ability of consciousness**; it is the whole of consciousness as it realizes its freedom. Each realistic and concrete state of consciousness in the world **promotes imagination** as long as it always presents itself to **go beyond reality**. And this does not mean that all consciousness of reality is transformed into **imaginative**, since consciousness is always conscious "in situation" because it is always free, there is always, and at every moment, for it a real possibility of producing what is unrealistic.

#### Sartre

#### **1-** Explain the text and state the problematic it raises. (9 points)

- Write <u>an appropriate introduction</u> on imagination.
- Write <u>a suitable problematic</u>. A general problem and a specific problem.
- Write <u>a preliminary idea</u>.
- **Explain** the ideas of the text which explains Sartre point view regarding imagination.
- Elaborate on the concept of imagination in reference to Sartre, Alain and Husserl.

- 2- Discuss the thesis of the text in light of the empiricist (7 points) theory on imagination.
  - Write <u>a transitional sentence</u> that links the explanation with the discussion.
  - Internal criticism: two ideas.
  - External criticism:
    - Explain the empiricist theory.
    - The point of view of Hume.
  - Write <u>a synthesis</u> joining both theories.

# 3- Do you think that watching movies improves (4 points) imagination? Justify your answer.

- **Explain** the question.
- Answer with yes, watching movies improves imagination (Justification and give two example).
- Answer with no watching movies does not improve imagination (Justification and give two example).
