Technology and the Education System

1 Technology has become an important part in different aspects of our lives but mostly in our education system. This is evident in the increased use of technological devices– from smart phones and boards to computer labs and online classes. Evolving technology in schools helps disabled children attend school with minimal aid, prepares students to use technology in the real world, and expands their abilities to acquire more knowledge about the world.

2 The new advances in technology have made it easier for students with both physical and mental disabilities to attend school. Recent innovations in wheelchairs have allowed students with physical disabilities to participate in sports with their fellow students. Along with wheelchairs, new speaking devices, like the electronic pointing device and sip and puff system, have been introduced to enable students with speaking and physical impairments to communicate. These devices can be used with a computer program that speaks out commands, comments or words, allowing the user to speak and communicate with other students and teachers. Furthermore, ear implants permit students who are profoundly deaf or severely hard of hearing to partake in school discussions and classes.

3 New advances in technology also prepare students for the real world, whether it is for a future job or investing and saving the money they will make from their jobs. In many classes, students use programs like Microsoft Word to write their essays and PowerPoint to do presentations. In the past, business students used Excel sheets to keep track of the stock market and programs to learn how to invest in it. Now, by learning how to use the computer to trade, **they** will be better equipped as adults to invest in stock markets and to keep track of their funds and investments. Later on, these skills will become useful for designing business cards and posters for a job or business. Through all these opportunities provided by technology in classes, students can use their knowledge to endorse themselves in the workplace when they are adults.

4 Advancing technology has given students more opportunities to interact with the world and widen their knowledge. Students can skype with people around the world. This makes **them** more cultivated and open to other countries and cultures. Students have become more aware of events that are happening all around the world. For example, social media have made it possible for people in different countries to watch Soccer Leagues live and celebrate the results. Without technology, this would never have been accessed by millions of people worldwide. In addition, students can publish their work online and write blogs for others to read.

5 Technology will always be evolving and advancing. It will continue to make life easier for disabled students, prepare students for future jobs, and educate them about the world. Technology and education will always go hand in hand as we live in a technology-influenced world.
