Technology and the Education System

- 1 Technology has become an important part in different forms of our lives but mostly in our education system. This is clear in using more technological devices— from smart phones and boards to computer labs and online classes. Technology in schools helps disabled children attend school with minimal help; it prepares students to use technology in the real world, and to attain more knowledge about the world.
- 2 The new advances in technology help students with both physical and mental disabilities to attend school. New innovations in wheelchairs have allowed students with physical disabilities to participate in sports with other students. Along with wheelchairs, ear implants have helped deaf students take part in class discussions. In addition, new speaking devices, like the electronic pointing device, have been introduced to allow students with speaking disabilities to communicate with other students and teachers.
- 3 Technology also prepares students for the real world, whether it is for a future job or spending and saving the money they will make from their jobs. In many classes, students use programs like Microsoft Word to write their essays and PowerPoint to do presentations. So by learning how to use the computer to buy and sell, **they** will be better equipped as adults to participate in markets and to follow their business. Later on, these skills will become useful for designing business cards and posters for a business.
- 4 Advancing technology has given students more opportunities to interact with the world. Students can skype with people around the world. This makes **them** more open to other countries and cultures. Students have become more aware of events that are happening all around the world. For example, social media have made it possible for people in different countries to watch Soccer Leagues live and celebrate the results. In addition, students can publish their work online and write blogs for others to read.
- 5 Technology will always be progressing and advancing. It will continue to make life easier for disabled students, prepare students for future jobs, and educate them about the world. Technology and education will always go together hand in hand as we live in a technology-influenced world.
