First Subject:

Tendencies do not exist outside the sensory experience.

1- Explain this judgment and state the problematic it raises. (9 points)
2- Discuss this judgment in light of another theory. (7 points)

3- Do you think that advertisements create new tendencies in humans? Justify your answer. **(4 points)**

Second Subject:

Humans are deceived when they believe that they are free.

1- Explain this judgment of Spinoza and state the problematic it raises. (9 points)

2- Discuss this judgment in light of other attitudes that assure the absolute freedom of man. (7 points)

3- Do you think that authority (of the family, school ...) limits the freedom of the individual? Justify you answer.

Third Subject: Text

Technology puts man in danger, not only because of the ability of the technical tools to completely destroy the human kind from now on, but because it threatens in depth the thinking essence of man, which means his relation to existence. [...]

Man who deals with all things and with himself from a calculated logic, is more concerned about all existing things that he seeks to control, hence he is no longer interested in what he should be concerned with more than anything else, that is, existence in itself. Since he is no longer concerned in getting close to the essence of things or in maintaining the way that they are revealed, then he is lost in a no-world. [...] The aggression of man against all what exists, has reached nowadays its climax in his attempt to control life itself, which has become like a product that man seeks to manipulate or change. This attack on life and on the essence of man, according to Heidegger, is more worrying than the bet on the destruction that threatens the planet, and that is due to the hiding of this attack.
